Safer People

Always provide constant adult supervision and never allow a child to be unattended. Develop swim skills through ongoing and qualified instruction. Learn and practice proper behavior in and around the water.

Safer Water

Install, maintain and utilize proper fencing, self-closing gates and latches when possible. Consider alarms, pool covers and other safety equipment to protect swimming perimeter. *No barrier is 100% effective.*

Safer Response

Learn and renew CPR, first-aid and rescue techniques through ongoing certification courses. Keep an emergency action plan, rescue equipment and phone by the pool at all times. *Safety First.*
